Budget Update - Jeremy Kiner

- Current Booster Balance: \$8,741.21
- Ruscilli check is in the mail \$1,500- still outstanding
- Capitol Fence \$1,500- still outstanding
- Drug Mart \$100- still outstanding
- CTE Balance: \$17,000
- 200 account balance approximately \$10,000
- Budget for FY26 - Jeremy shared a projected overall budget that includes Booster, CTE and 200 spending and will work on creating a projected budget for just Booster spending- done
- Reminder of student booster participation fee of \$75 due August 29th
- Fundraising Update
 - Ben's sponsorship document is done and has been sent out to potential donors.
